FINDINGS:

Clinical Indication: Rule out calculus.

Technique CT abdomen and pelvis without IV or oral contrast.

Comparison: 27/10/2009.

The previously seen pleural effusions have resolved. The displaced cholecystectomy clip and the cystic abnormality in the gallbladder fossa which may represent dilated remnant cystic duct remains unchanged. The small approximately 2 mm calculus within the right upper pole calyx remains unchanged. The double-J stent is noted in situ and there is no evidence of ureteric calculus. No evidence of pelvicaliectasis. With the limitations of an unenhanced scan the visualized liver, spleen, adrenals, pancreas are unremarkable. The high attenuation of the mesenteric fat and several small lymph nodes within it representing mesentery panniculitis remains unchanged. The retroperitoneum is clear. There is no free fluid within the abdomen. Colonic diverticulosis but no evidence of acute complication is again noted. No aggressive bony lesion.

INTERPRETATION:

No evidence of ureteric calculus.
